

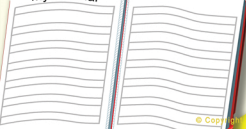
Devotion:

Children of Ghana

Ghana is a country on the coast of West Africa and the meaning of the word Ghana is "Warrior King." The children of Ghana eat foods like Banku, a dish made from corn dough and cassava (a type of plant root). They also eat fried and boiled plantains (a kind of banana), rice, fish, mixed vegetables, and groundnuts. The country of Ghana still has the highest percentage of Christians in West Africa, however it is still very common for others there to follow the traditional animist religions. Pray that God will draw those who do not yet know Jesus to Him, so they may experience the pleasant words of the One True God over all creation!
