Fish Symbol - Very early the fish became a symbol of Christianity. During persecution by the Romans, Christians used this symbol as a secret Code to discover whether or not another person was a Christian. The first letters of the Greek words for "Jesus Christ" spell the Greek word for "fish" (IXOYC). They were also used boldly as a means of identification among Christians because it had no significance to unbelievers. Jesus himself said he would make his disciples "fishers of men".



Fishing for men: what does that mean? You are the bait. Your life should attract people to God's way, just like worms attract fish to the hook. Your friends should notice a difference in you; then when they ask you about the secret to your peace, and joy, you can tell them about Jesus.
